



Air Pistol (Pellet) Event Rules

Number of Individual Entrants per County: No limit.
Number of Team Entrants per County: Individual only.
Age Division Determination: Age on January 1, 2021.

Air Pistol (Pellet) Contest Divisions:

Junior	Ages 12-14
Senior	Ages 15-19

Equipment, Targets, Rules, and Course of Fire

1. Participants will use the Crossman 1377C/PC77/P1377 – 3 pump max. **No** modifications allowed.
2. Pellets are .177 wad cutter 7.4 gr.
3. Target will be the Target B-40-4 type cut in half horizontally.

Course of fire: 3 x 10:

- a. 10 shots in **sitting position at bench with rest**
- b. 10 shots in **standing two-handed**
- c. 10 shots in **standing one-handed**

Times for event, for each position:

- a. 5 min preparation time
 - b. 5 min for first target/bull
 - c. 5 min for second target/bull
4. Competition will be on the 10 meter range.
 5. Empty Chamber Indicators (E.C.I.) are mandatory.
 6. No other equipment unless approved by tournament director.

Pistols must be transported to the range in a proper gun case (One pistol per case). All pistols will be brought up to the firing line while still cased and will remain, until instructed by the range officer. Participants who violate this rule will be disqualified. This rule has been established to promote and maintain a safe environment for everyone at the tournament site.
