Sixth Year Requirements: Including reports, summaries, samples and collections. <i>(40 points maximum, each category worth 10 points ea)</i> - 3 examples of judging conformation. - Describe 3 examples of judging a pleasure horse <i>(i.e. headset, rein length)</i> - Describe 2 different ways of riding <i>(hunt seat, western, etc.)</i> - 4 examples of poisonous plants		
Completion: Was the notebook completed, done by the 4-Her. Project suited to age & years of experience of member. <i>(10 points maximum)</i>		
Neatness: Outside cover neat & attractive. Papers neatly arranged, numbered and indexed by year. Handwriting or typing neat. Pictures, pamphlets & brochures fastened. <i>(20 points maximum)</i>
